Our School

Westbourne Grammar is a leading Independent school in Melbourne. The School has a dynamic curriculum and values learning, hard work, honesty, integrity, self-responsibility and mutual respect.

Our school focus for each student is on academic excellence and personal development, to give each student opportunities to reach their full potential in an increasingly complex world. Westbourne Grammar School is a non-denominational Christian school and all students attend chapel on a regular basis.

The Westbourne student body consists of 746 males and 663 female students and includes students from a diverse range of cultural and religious backgrounds.

The main school campus is located on fifty hectares at Truganina, twenty minutes drive from the Melbourne CBD. It has a Children's Centre, Kindergarten, Junior and Senior School and was established in 1978. The School's original campus established in 1867 is at Williamstown with classes from Prep to Year 3.

The majority of Westbourne students live in the western suburbs of Melbourne, such as; Williamstown, Werribee, Point Cook, Sanctuary Lakes and Hoppers Crossing. A network of school buses services the Western metropolitan area to transport students to and from school.

Governance

Westbourne is a public company limited by guarantee; its directors form the School Council which has responsibility for the Governance of the School, determining general policy and setting the School's Strategic direction. Operational matters are delegated to the Principal.

The academic performance of the School in 2010 was very strong.

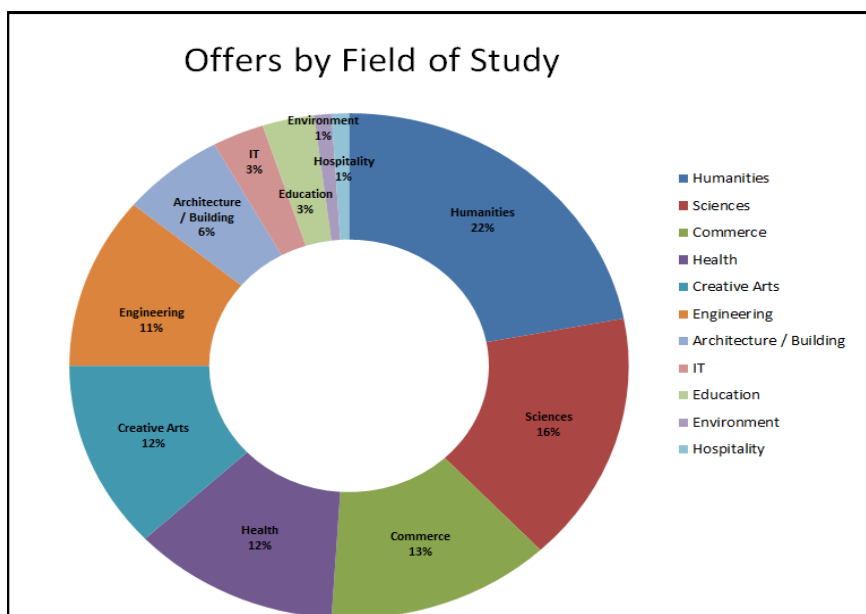
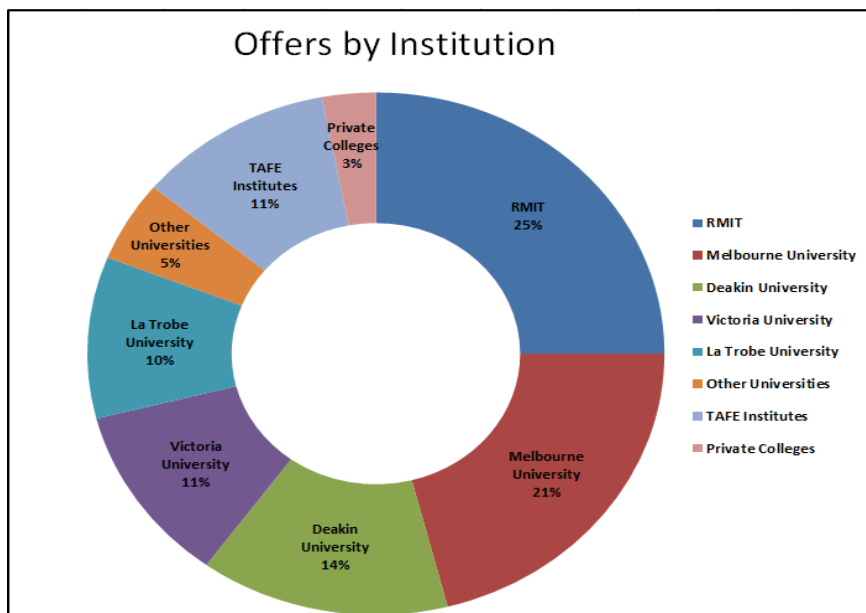
VCE results

Highlights of the 2010 VCE results included:

- 100% pass rate
- The median ATAR for the class of 2010 was 80.45. The median ATAR has been above 80 for the last five years
- 2 students achieved an ATAR above 99
- 21 students achieved an ATAR above 95 (15%)
- 34 students achieved an ATAR above 90 (24%)
- 53% of the class achieved an ATAR above 80 placing them in the top 20% of students across the state.

Tertiary Placements

Offers received by the students in the Class of 2010 are summarised below:



The annual '**On Track**' survey provides the Victorian public with information on the destinations of all Year 12 school leavers in Victoria on a school by school basis.

- 80% of Westbourne's Class of 2010 enrolled in a university course in 2011, a further 8% deferred their university offer
- 10% enrolled in Tafe courses (including apprenticeship training)
- 2% of our students directly entered the work force
- 0% were unemployed.

NAPLAN

Each year all students in Australia sit national standardised tests at Years 3, 5, 7 and 9. These tests are designed to measure National Performance in Literacy and Numeracy.

The 2010 National Testing results show that Westbourne students are performing well above state and national benchmarks. Our 2010 results were an improvement on the 2009 results, which were also well above state and national benchmarks. A summary of our NAPLAN Results for 2010 follows. Highlights from the reports include:

Year 3

- 97% of Westbourne and Williamstown students were above the minimum standard for reading, 100% for writing, 100% for spelling punctuation and 100% for grammar
- In reading the median for both campuses is above the State median – 1.0 band at Williamstown and 1.5 bands at Westbourne
- In writing 86% of students performed 1 to 2 bands above the national average performance
- 70% of students are performing at least 1 band above the State average in punctuation and grammar
- 100% of students in Grade 3 are working at or above the National minimum standard in numeracy

Year 5

- 97% of Westbourne students achieved the national minimum standard for reading, 96% for writing, 92% for spelling, 95% for punctuation and grammar, 99% for numeracy

Year 7

- Westbourne Grammar School's 2010 NAPLAN results are well above the state and national averages
- 98% of students are performing above the national minimum standard for reading, 98% for spelling, 92% for grammar and punctuation and 97% for numeracy
- 94% of students are performing above the national minimum standard for writing
- In reading and numeracy 50% of students are performing in the top 25% of the State.

Year 9

- 99% of students are performing at or above the national minimum standard for reading, 88% for writing, 96% for spelling, 98% for grammar and

punctuation and 99% for numeracy; 95% are performing above the national standard in these areas

- 75% of all Year 9 students are above the State median score for reading, writing, spelling, grammar and punctuation and numeracy
- 50% of our students are above the top 25% in the State in reading, writing, spelling, grammar and punctuation and numeracy

Attendance

The total average attendance rates of all students in 2010 were:

- Williamstown Campus 95.3%

For Senior School students, the Head of House will contact parents to discuss reasons for unexplained absence and the Head of Senior School will follow up with parents if the absence becomes excessive.

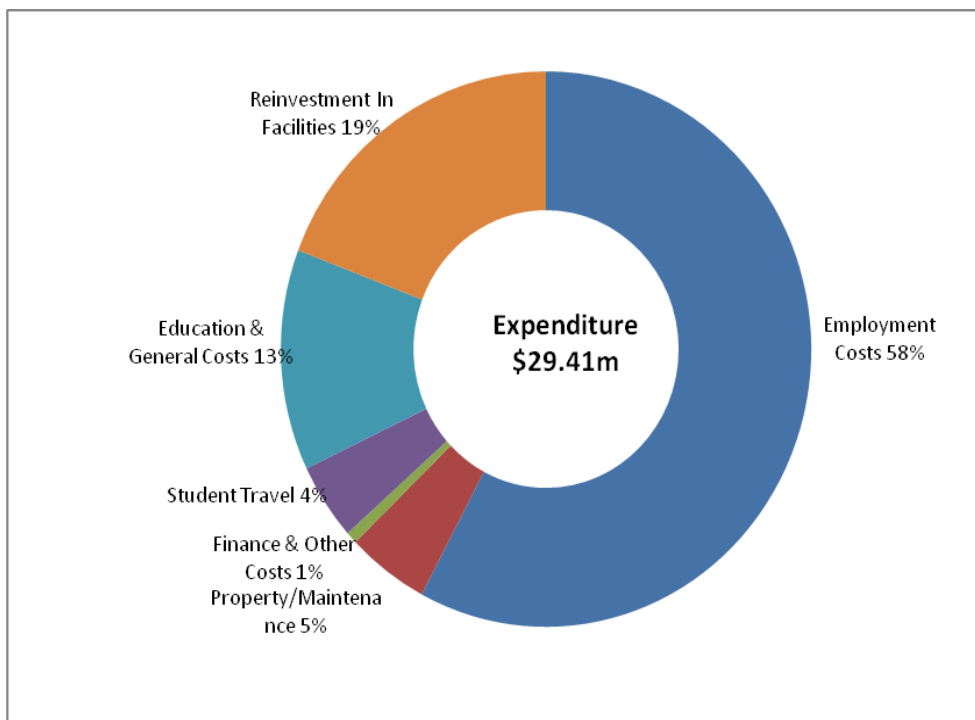
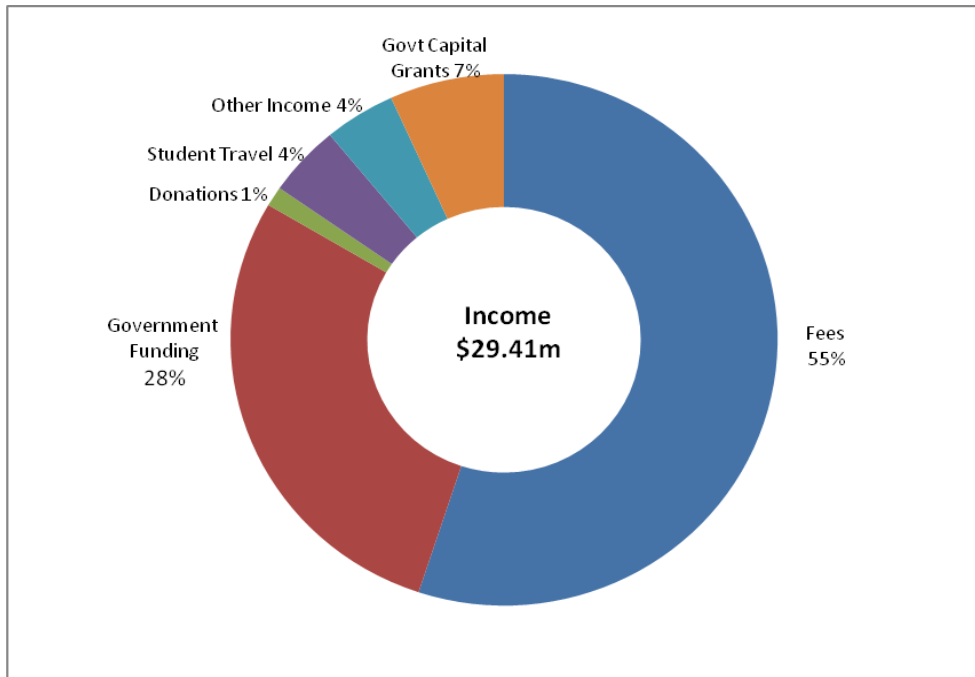
Parent Satisfaction

Westbourne Grammar School conducts Parent Information evenings for every year level of the School. Westbourne also distributes a fortnightly Bulletin to all members of the School community.

The parents of all departing students are invited to complete a 'Parent Satisfaction Survey'. All surveys received are collated and analysed. 96% of returns received for 2010 indicated that respondents were satisfied or very satisfied with the standard of educational services provided by Westbourne Grammar School.
