CELEBRATION OF OUTSTANDING ALUMNI AWARDS

Westbourne Grammar School proudly acknowledges alumni who have demonstrated outstanding personal, community or professional achievement since leaving the School. These awards celebrate past students from Strathmore Grammar School, and Westbourne and Williamstown Grammar School who continue to uphold and live by the values instilled by the School. The recognition of these alumni not only serves to inspire current students but also provide staff, past and present, with a great sense of pride and satisfaction in knowing their students are having such a positive impact on the world.

The award will be presented to alumni who have demonstrated significant accomplishments in their personal or professional life, or service to their community, state or nation.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Nominees for an alumni award must have completed at least three years of schooling at Strathmore, Westbourne or Williamstown Grammar School and have, over an extensive and sustained period of time, demonstrated professional and personal success in at least three of the following areas.

1. Outstanding professional achievements

- a. Recognised as a leader/expert in their field
- b. Significant achievement(s) throughout their career
- c. A younger alumni who is an early career achiever in what would normally be considered a relatively short period of time

2. Significant community service achievements

- a. Support of, and significant involvement in, the community in a voluntary capacity
- b. Dedication of significant personal/professional time for charitable/community support activities

3. Inspirational leadership within their fields of expertise

- a. Mentoring employees/younger people inside or outside their organisation
- b. Advocacy of access and diversity within their organisations and across their field
- c. Providing leadership within and across their respective industries

4. Outstanding personal qualities

- a. Demonstrated citizenship and has upheld the School's values of creativity, scholarship, courage and community
- b. Exhibited good moral and ethical behaviour, as judged by acceptable social standards
- c. Established a distinguished reputation at the local, state, national or international level.



PROCEDURE

- Any member of the Westbourne community including alumni members, School staff, School Council, Principal and members of the public may nominate an individual, including those members of the community who are no longer with us. Alumni may also self-nominate.
- The nominator will complete the nomination form, accompanied by a resume, and forward to the secretary of the Alumni Association Committee through the Development Office
- The Alumni Association Committee will short-list candidates and will refer these to the Principal and School Board for final selection
- The awards process will remain confidential from the nominees until a decision has been made by the Principal and Board. The information on the nomination form will be used by the Alumni Association Committee in connection with the administration of the award only. All information will remain confidential
- Submissions should be made by 31 July 2018 and awarded recipients will be notified in September. Recipients will be publicly announced and presented with the award during the School's Westbourne Celebrates Event in October 2018
