TUITION FEES

Junior School	Prep to Grade 1	AU\$23,590 per year
Junior School	Grade 2 - 3	AU\$24,310 per year
Junior School	Grade 4 - 6	AU\$26,060 per year

Junior School fees are all inclusive - camps, books, stationery, excursions.

Senior School	Year 7	AU\$30,180 per year
Senior School	Year 8 - 9	AU\$30,800 per year
Senior School	Year 10 - 12	AU\$31,720 per year (includes VCAA fees)

OTHER COSTS AND POTENTIAL FEES

School Uniforms	Approximately	\$1000 - \$1500
Text books and stationery, online resources Mainstream classes	Approximately	\$200 - \$400 depending on year level*
Text books and stationery, online resources Secondary Preparation Program	Approximately	\$100 - \$200 depending on year level*

Transport	Each student is levied a bus fee depending on which bus they catch. The bus fee can range up to approximately \$2,300 year.

Music	Fees charged for Music lessons in 2019 will be: Private lessons \$344 per term (8 lessons)

Absence from School does not constitute the making up of a lesson unless the teacher is informed prior to the session.

Instrument Hire

Cancellations of lessons requires one term's written notice to the Director of Music. Failure to do so will result in one half term's fee being charged.

Guardianship	Department of Immigration and Border Protection (DIBP) requires all students under 18 years of age to have a Guardian. Westbourne Grammar School requires all international students over 18 to also have a Guardian. If you cannot provide your own Guardian the School suggests: International Student Alliance (www.studentguardians.com). Fees for this service will be charged by the provider. Please note: Homestay families cannot be Guardians.
Spending Money	Parental decision. It is suggested that students have access to approximately \$120 per week for personal expenses or pocket money. There will be incidental voluntary social events which may have associated costs like the Presentation Ball, School Formal, performances, concerts or overseas trips.
Notebook Program	Notebook computers Students in Years 7 – 12 are required to have a school notebook computer. These will be loaned to the students at no additional cost and will be issued within the first weeks of the 2019 school year. Please note that additional costs may be incurred should this notebook be damaged / lost / stolen while on loan.
Voluntary Activities Additional Costs	There are a number of non-compulsory, voluntary activities such as specific camps, private music lessons, sport camps/tours, cultural and social tours, Year level Balls and other optional co-curricular activities on offer at the School. Students who wish to participate will be advised of the costs and requirements well in advance to enable parents to make a decision for their child to participate.
OTHER	
Family Discount	5% discount on tuition fees for the second sibling, 10% discount on tuition fees for the third sibling and 20% on tuition fees for the fourth sibling is applicable.
Fees in Advance Discount	Parents who wish to pay the full year's tuition fees in one payment before 1 February will be given a 2.5% discount.
Late Fee	If the fee for a term is not paid by the stated due date an accounting charge of AU\$125 will be payable by the parent.
Withdrawal of Students	The School's Business Terms require written notice be provided to the Principal advising of the intention to withdraw a student from the School. If adequate notice is not given, charges will incur as per the School's International Student Written Agreement.

Students choosing to study a subject or course at a school other than Westbourne (including VCE subjects and languages other than English not offered at Westbourne) will be responsible for all associated fees for that subject or course.

All fees are reviewed annually.
